No entry in the office.

Please don't arrive more than 5 mins before your session start time and leave promptly at the end of your session. We have gaps between the sessions to allow us time for cleaning of tack and facilities to avoid cross contamination.

If you or any member of your household has covid symptoms or are awaiting a test result, please do not attend the yard for 14 days from the first day of symptoms.

Please don't bring any other belongings with you apart from those required for riding and a named water bottle.

Please bring appropriate clothing for the weather, we are unable to lend anything.

Pony Club Rallies

We will continue to work towards the E, D, D+, C, C+ and B Efficiency Tests and Achievement/Mini Achievement Badges.
